

BY William C. Mann WASHINGTON -- The government has added Egypt to its list of the world's worst violators of religious rights. A government report on religious freedom, which is released annually, said the situation in Egypt for religious minorities, especially Coptic Christians, has deteriorated markedly since former President Hosni Mubarak (HAHS'-nee moo-BAH'-rahk) resigned in February.

China also is on the list of worst violators, compiled by the **Commission on International Religious Freedom**. In opening remarks as he released the report Thursday, commission Chairman Leonard Leo accused China of trying to hack into the commission's emails.
