

## **Bhekithemba Makhubu (m)**

**Adoption Status:** Not Adopted


**Country:** Swaziland

**Occupation:** Columnist and Editor-in-Chief of *The Nation*

**Detained Since:** March 17, 2014

**Charges:** Criminal contempt of court

**Sentence:** Two years imprisonment



**Additional:** Makhubu was arrested on March 17, 2014 on charges of criminal contempt of court following the publication of articles criticizing the judicial system of Swaziland. The articles, published in February and March, questioned circumstances surrounding the arrest of government vehicle inspector, Bhantshana Vincent Gwebu and criticized the lack of impartiality of the Swazi judicial system.

The legality of the arrest, detention and charges against Makhubu was successfully challenged and the Swazi High Court ordered them released from custody but two days later they were rearrested and detained when the State appealed the ruling. On July 17, 2014, Makhubu was convicted for “contempt of court” by Swaziland’s High Court. The conviction followed a grossly unfair trial where the presiding judge, Mpendulo Simelane, had declared the trial would be held outside normal law and procedures.
