Occupation: Medical doctor and the chairman of the Islamic Religious Affairs Council in Maungdaw



Detained Since: June 11, 2012

Charges: Being connected to the riots at a local mosque, having 100 Chinese Yuan in his wallet while detained, and having a mobile phone with a SIM card from Bangladesh

Sentence: Initially sentenced to serve 11 years in prison. However, the prosecution appealed to elongate his sentence on the basis of leniency, and as a result, his term was increased to 17 years.

Additional: Aung was originally held in Sittwe Prison but on February 6, 2014, he was transferred to Insein Prison in Rangoon and his family is no longer allowed to visit him.
