



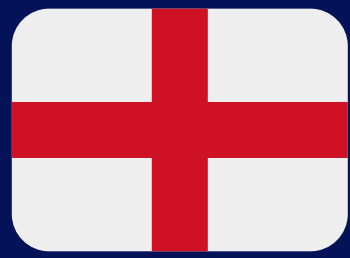
# ANTI-SEMITISM AROUND THE WORLD IN 2019: MID-YEAR SNAPSHOT

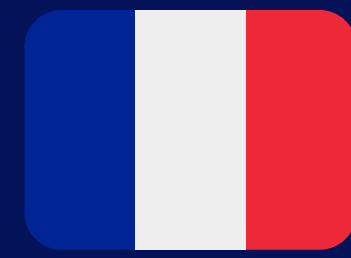
**Argentina**  
June

Three men violently assaulted a rabbi who was walking alone.



**England**  
February

An assailant beat a sixty-nine year old man after asking if he was Jewish.



**France**  
April

Two students urinated on the property of a Jewish student union.



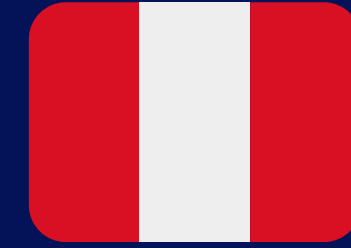
**Kenya**  
April

Five men attacked and robbed a rabbi and his wife in their synagogue.



**Oman**  
February

A government-sponsored book fair sold infamous anti-Semitic books.



**Peru**  
January

The governor of the Junin region referenced "Jewish-Peruvian powers" in control of the country.



**Poland**  
April

Residents of Pruchnik beat, hanged, and burnt an effigy of an Orthodox Jew as part of an Easter ritual.



**Romania**  
April

Vandals knocked over and smashed 73 headstones in a cemetery in the town of Husi.



**Turkey**  
April

An unidentified man threw a Molotov cocktail at a synagogue in Izmir.
